

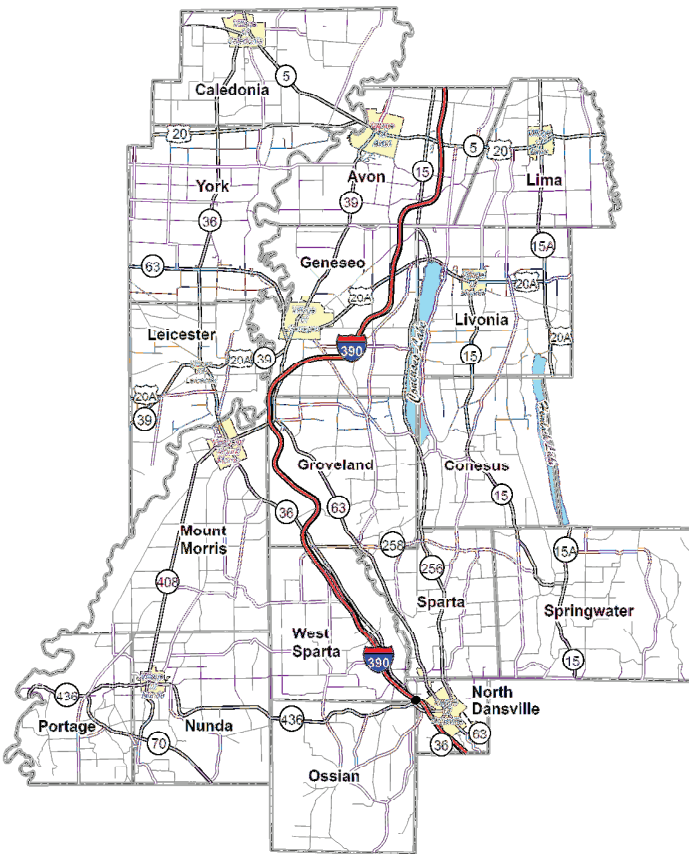


TRANSPORTATION

MAJOR ROUTES

Within the United States, truck delivery is often the most economical method. One-third of the US population is within a one day's drive of Livingston County.

The County is 10 minutes south of the NYS Thruway I-90 on Interstate 390, western New York's only north-south expressway.

AIRPORTS

Greater Rochester International Airport

Primary Use Runway:

- 4/22 8,001' long by 150' wide
- Equipped with ILS and high intensity approach lighting

Secondary Use Runway:

- 10/28 6,401' long by 150' wide
- Used for crosswinds operations

General Aviation Runway:

- 7/25 4,000' long by 140' wide
- Used for non-jet aircraft

RAIL

Two active short line railroads, **Genesee and Wyoming Inc.** and **Livonia, Avon & Lakeville Railroad Corporation**, both provide direct interconnections with four Class I railroads: Norfolk Southern, CSX, Canadian National, and Canadian Pacific mainline railroad.
