Revolving Loan Fund

- Started year with 9 active loans
- One new loan approved (C&J Transport)
- Two paid off (Scaccia and Schuster)
- Ended year with 8 active loans
- Over \$550,000 available in revolving loan fund

- \$500,000 grant administered in Mt Morris, Dansville, Geneseo – will close out in 2017
- \$20,000 technical assistance grant administered and closed in Avon
